The *Reuhurinne* series of books by author Tuula Kallioniemi began in 1997. The series contains a range of books from children's novels to non-fiction and puzzle books.

NFC technology (Near Field Communication) enables entire new ways of content distribution. By simply touching an object, such as a book, smartphones can access digital services or send and gather data. Finnish technology company FinnCode Ltd is responsible for the development of the Reuhurinne Ekstra app and the implementation of NFC technology.
